



## HYDE PARK DAY SCHOOL

### SUMMER LEARNING OPPORTUNITY

Hyde Park Day School is excited to offer a summer learning opportunity for students currently in first through third grades who struggle with reading and spelling. This program is designed for bright students who have not yet received a formal diagnosis of a learning disability but demonstrate signs of being at-risk for reading difficulties. This is a six-week, intensive, multisensory program that provides instruction in a small group (5:1) setting. The program is designed to support students who are not developing reading, spelling, and writing skills as expected, given their intelligence and auditory comprehension skills. Students may also choose to participate in a math program designed to build foundational math concepts, problem-solving skills, and number sense, while developing the “language” and vocabulary of math.

HPDS students are curious, intelligent, and ready to learn. Hyde Park Day School is not equipped to accept students who have behavioral difficulties, social-emotional challenges, or children who are on the autism spectrum.

Students might be struggling with:

- \* Identifying sounds within words
- \* Identifying sounds and letters
- \* Blending sounds together
- \* Reading–decoding
- \* Reading–oral fluency
- \* Written expression
- \* Reading comprehension compared to auditory comprehension
- \* Strategies for solving math word problems
- \* Math computation, number sense, and math fact fluency

Our admissions process is thoughtful and comprehensive. The process is designed to help HPDS and your family determine if our summer program is the right fit for your child.

Before you get started on the application, here is what you need to know:

TUITION: Language Arts \$2,900.00 Math \$1,350.00

#### **Admissions Procedure:**

Please submit all of the following. You will find links to application forms on our website [hydeparkday.org](http://hydeparkday.org).

- \* Parent application form
- \* Release of information form
- \* Progress report cards from school for the past two years
- \* Parent statement
- \* Teacher questionnaire (to be distributed to teachers by parents and submitted directly to HPDS by teachers)
- \* IEP, if your child has one
- \* All evaluations for academics, speech-language, or occupational therapy, including evaluations from Early Intervention Services.

Hyde Park Day School will confirm receipt of a complete application. We will contact you within two weeks of receipt of a complete application to inform you if HPDS appears to be a good fit for your child. We will invite qualified candidates in for a screening that will take place at HPDS.

A final decision regarding admissions will be made within one week of the screening. If HPDS is not the best fit for your child’s needs, we will offer suggestions for other programs that will better serve your child.
